





# Five New Shriners Hospitals Will Open for Children

Officers of Ben Hur Temple of the Mystic Shrine have received notice that additional facilities for treating crippled children and restoring them to normal conditions soon will be provided through the completion of five new units of the Shriners Hospitals for crippled children. It is possible that little cripples who have applied through the temple for admittance to one of the Shrine Hospitals and found a long waiting list ahead of them may receive the benefits of surgical treatment much sooner through the addition of the new units, which will relieve the congestion in existing hospitals.

Added facilities for meeting the enormous demand by little folk with crooked spines, crooked limbs and club feet will be provided by the opening, sometime in January, of a fifty-bed hospital in Springfield, Mass., and one of similar capacity in Montreal, Canada, and mobile units with headquarters in existing general hospitals at Salt Lake City, Spokane, Washington and Winnipeg, Canada. Already in operation are the Shriners Hospitals in St. Louis, San Francisco, Portland, Ore. And the twin cities of Minneapolis and St. Paul, Minn. These have a total capacity of 300 beds. They are constantly filled, with nearly 100 children registered and on the waiting lists. Sites for large hospitals have been selected in Philadelphia and Chicago, and work is soon to begin.

There are no strict territorial lines drawn by these hospitals and children may be sent from this city to any one of them where there is an opening, but it is general policy of the institutions to give preference to patients in their own region of the country, that long journeys may be avoided.

The opening of the Shriner's hospitals for crippled children two years ago has brought out the surprising fact that there are more than 400,000 little cripples in the US. The parents of many of these children can pay for surgical treatment, but the Mystic Shrine is interested in only those whose families cannot afford the cost. The Shrine Hospitals are open to all children, white or black, without regard to religion or fraternal affiliation. The only requirements are that the child be under fourteen years old and the case promises reasonable hope of material improvement and that the family is unable to bear the expense of operations or hospital treatment.

The hospitals are supported entirely by the more than 500,000 members of the Mystic Shrine who pay \$2.00 a year each to the hospital fund, providing more than a million dollars a year to this work. No call has ever been made upon the outside public, though in cities where the hospitals have been opened there have been generous gifts of equipment from civic clubs, other organizations, and individuals.
