HISTORY

Mystic Shriners Meet in Chicago for Imperial Session 1889

The Chicago Tribune covered the Imperial Session of the Ancient Order of the Nobles of the Mystic Shrine in Chicago in June 1889. The Fraternity had been in existence since 1872 and was still in its infancy. The coverage included a lengthy dissertation on the history of the Mystic Shriners.

The Tribune reported that there were 400 sons of Mahomet in town, honorary descendants of the true prophet entitled among the faithful to wear the green turban. One of them could meet a band of blood thirsty Bedouins on the great desert and by a pass of his hand and an ancient word turn them instantly into brothers who would make his welfare their welfare. Grave sheiks they are, decorated with shining crescents and golden scimitars. They are Nobles of the Ancient Arabic Order of Nobles of the Mystic Shrine or Mystic Shriners.

The Tribune goes on to describe what a Shriner is. To be a Shriner one must be a man of high degree thirty-two of them, in fact, duly worked out in the Masonic order. Only Sir Knights and Scottish Rite Templars who have attained the thirty-second degree are eligible to be a member of the Mystic Shrine, and so it naturally follows that the Shriners form a splendid body of men.

The Shriners are in Chicago for the Imperial Council of North America. Their business was the election of officers for the next triennial period, dispensing charters to new temples and making some changes in the laws governing the order.

Imperial Potentate Samuel Briggs announced that the membership in the order is now 10,175 nobles, an increase of 3,000 during the year. The order has grown to this size since 1871 when Dr. Flemming introduced the order into America. It was translated from ancient Arabic papers brought from the Orient by William Florence, and others brought from Egypt by Sherwood Campbell. That was the year that the order was conferred on thirteen eminent Masons who founded Mecca temple in New York. The Imperial Council of North America was instituted by Mecca temple and began granting charters to new temples. As of 1889, there are now fifty temples with Mecca temple having 1300 members.

William Patterson, an eminent Arabic scholar and enthusiast on this subject traces the origins of the order to at least year 64 AD when all the symbols and rituals practiced in America today were observed by the Bedouins of Arabia. The order still exists in the same form in Arabia and Egypt.

The transactions of the order are written in Arabic. The records of the Imperial Council Meeting are written in Arabic which one noble describes as like an effort to write shorthand with some printer's ink and pine stick. When a poor son of the desert is initiated into the order, he isn't even allowed to ride a goat. He must travel the heated sands on foot in a pilgrimage to Mecca. The Koran is used throughout the exercises.

The officers were elected for the next triennial and San Francisco was chosen as the site for the next Imperial Session.

It was noted that the headquarters of the council are in the Grand Pacific Hotel Club Room 4. Here great punch bowls were stirred to the beat of an orchestra playing Arabic melodies. Thirsty Arabs found an oasis as pleasing as any in the great desert.

Wearing of Helmets in Shrine Competitions

General Order No. 1, Series 2025-2026, became effective October 1, 2025. One of the changes in this General Order, found on page 24, states: "Contestants in Shrine hosted motorized vehicle competitions must wear a DOT approved helmet when operating a motorized vehicle in ALL competition events." [View the relevant provision of the Shriners International Protocol.](#)

Therefore, competition leaders at the Association level need to be sure there is full compliance with this order. Temple Potentates need to be sure that their motorized unit participants know to bring approved helmets to competition events.

Please note this provision of the General Order does not require participants in Shrine or civic parades to wear helmets.

As it relates to the issue of wearing helmets in parades, if required by law, they must be worn. If not required by law, the temple Potentate, in his discretion, may require his Nobility to wear helmets, pursuant to the issuance of an order made pursuant to the provisions of §327.1(h) of the bylaws of Shriners International. The language governing the wearing of helmets in parades is found in Shriners Protocol Book, September 2025 on page 5, set forth in full below.

"Shrine Parade Regulations."

"6. Safety laws. Motorcycles, scooters, and other motorized vehicles shall obey local laws Regarding speed, prudent operation, and the use of hard helmets. In states where helmets are not required, the temple potentate may direct helmet use for safety reasons instead of fezzes."

Please be sure that participants in Shrine competitions wear approved helmets when competing. Thank you for making sure Shrine competitions remain fun and safe.

The Transylvanian Onion Calendar

Every winter in the mountain village where I grew up, families took part in the **calendarul cu ceapă**, the onion calendar. This ritual is older than the ringing church bells and the ancient oak tree whose roots have cracked the village square for centuries. Maybe even as old as some of our Past Potentates.

The tradition is simple, at least on the surface. On New Year's Eve, the night before Saint Vasile (January 1st), each family slices a large onion into twelve petals, one for each month of the coming year. They sprinkle a pinch of salt into each petal and lay them out on a wooden board overnight. By morning, the salt will have either drawn out moisture or stayed dry. A wet petal predicts a rainy month; a dry one means drought. Some families add herbs or slip in tiny scraps of paper with wishes, but the onion's message is always about the weather.

My grandmother, the high priestess of tradition in our family, took the onion calendar seriously. She'd been making it for more years than she cared to say, and swore its predictions were more reliable than anything on TV. Most villagers agreed. If the calendar said April would be wet, people postponed weddings. If August looked dry, shepherds changed their grazing routes.

But this year, something unusual happened. Naturally, or I wouldn't be writing about it in this story.

Another custom is to party all night and greet the new year with homemade moonshine. Most people sneak a nap, as long as they're awake at dawn. Even the state TV channel aired pre-recorded music and jokes, blissfully free of propaganda, at least for that one night.

One New Year's morning, Grandpa overdid his toasting, got drunk and knocked over the wooden board. Onion petals scattered across the floor, and nobody could tell which petal represented which month. Grandma



was furious. She redid the whole thing the next evening. To her surprise, the predictions turned out just as accurate as ever.

So don't be too quick to plan your wedding or grazing route around salted onion petals. But if you do, consider pinning them down with thumbtacks, like my grandmother started doing after that year.
