## GOLD !      GOLD !      GOLD !

### BEN HUR SHRINE GOLDEN JUBILEE NOV 7-8, 1941

Nineteen forty one found the Ben Hur Shrine of Austin, Texas making plans for the Golden Jubilee Celebration of the Temple on November 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup>. Temple Potentates and Recorders from Wichita Falls, Amarillo, El Paso, Galveston, Houston, San Antonio, Fort Worth, Dallas and Waco along with their ladies have already acknowledged their intentions to be in attendance.

The activities on Friday night will commence with an "electrical parade" of the uniformed bodies and decorated automobiles of the temple officers. After the parade the Austin Symphony Orchestra will compliment Ben Hur Temple with a concert at the Austin High School Auditorium at 9:00PM.

The business session of the Temple will be held on Saturday, November 8<sup>th</sup> at 11:00AM. Upon conclusion of the business session, the nobles and ladies will be entertained with a "Womanless Wedding" with member of the caste from the Swedish Lutheran Church. At 3:00PM Herman Yerger, the Hindu magi from Burma India will perform feats of magic followed by the Hindu snake mystery.

At 4:30PM the first section of the ceremonial will begin with the traditional banquet at 5:30PM. The second section of the ceremonial will commence at 6:30PM. During this session, twelve new nobles were initiated into the mysteries of the Ancient Order. Following the second section ceremonial the nobles and ladies will be entertained with a dance at the Driskill Hotel Crystal Ballroom.

***Excerpt from the message of Ben Hur Illustrious Potentate Charles Petet:***

***While we are an organization whose primary purpose is having a good time, let us not overlook the splendid opportunity to help in the all-important work with the institutions which have for their purpose rendering aid to those not so fortunate as we are. It is my firm conviction that our greatest joy comes from doing favors for others and not receiving favors. A man who expects more from his government than he puts into it is not a good citizen, and a man who expects the Shrine membership, which he carries, and sometimes boasts of, to bring him joy and happiness, will be sadly disappointed if he fails to aid in the activities of his Temple. There is great work to be done by the Shrine, and it needs active cooperation of every member. Therefore, I call upon the entire Nobility of Ben Hur Temple to take part in the entertainment, the joy ride, the pleasures and profit inherent to an active membership.***


