## Ben Hur Shriners Induct Traffic Cop to Work Congested Intersection

During the recent Shrine Ceremonial in downtown Austin one of the novices was dressed in a high hat and linen duster and assigned to work traffic at 6<sup>th</sup> and Congress Ave. He was wearing a ball and chain as well as being handcuffed. The novice was ordered to maintain an orderly traffic flow at this congested intersection until such time as he was relieved of his duties. The "cop" was performing his duties as required except for when one of the vehicles was driven by a pretty girl. These conveyances were stopped, and traffic was held up while the "officer" explained in great detail the traffic laws and reasons for obeying them.

When the Shriners who had assembled on the side to observe the novice in action, they realized that many of the young ladies would drive down the street and make a Uturn to again be stopped and lectured. They quickly decided that the job was too strenuous and released their victim from his assignment quickly escorting him to a place far removed from feminine attraction.

On this same corner was a blind newspaper vendor. Another novice was assigned to take the entire inventory of newspapers from the vendor and sell them in a given time or risk buying all of them himself. The novice was blessed with a voice like a foghorn and succeeded in selling all of the vendor's papers in short order resulting in the pockets of the vendor jingling like the pockets of an unmarried man. It was said that many people purchased papers that day that did not even know that Austin had a newspaper.

The initiation of the novices followed the ceremonial on Friday November 20<sup>th</sup> in which the entire ceremonial divan was composed of Past Potentates of Ben Hur Shrine Temple. Once the candidates have walked across the hot sands, a dance was held at the Scottish Rite Cathedral.


