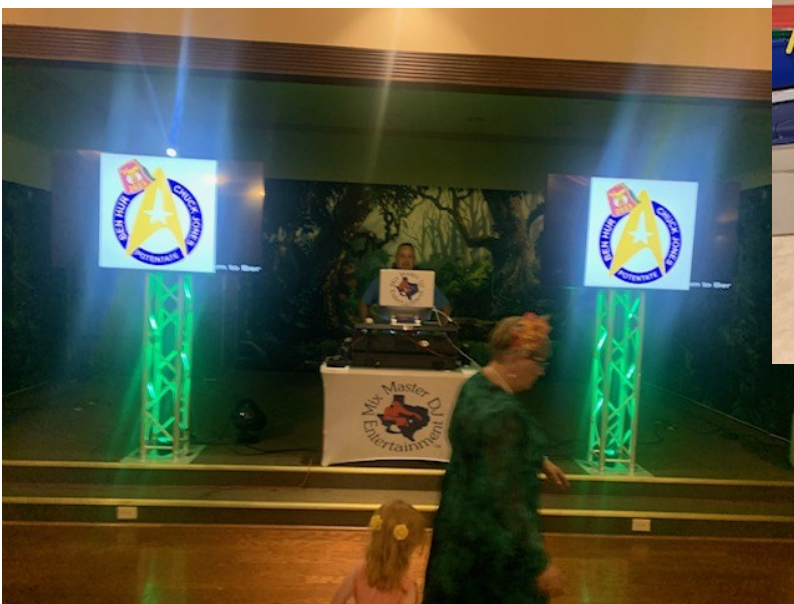

A special shout out to the Ladies of the LOH who make our fellowship possible.

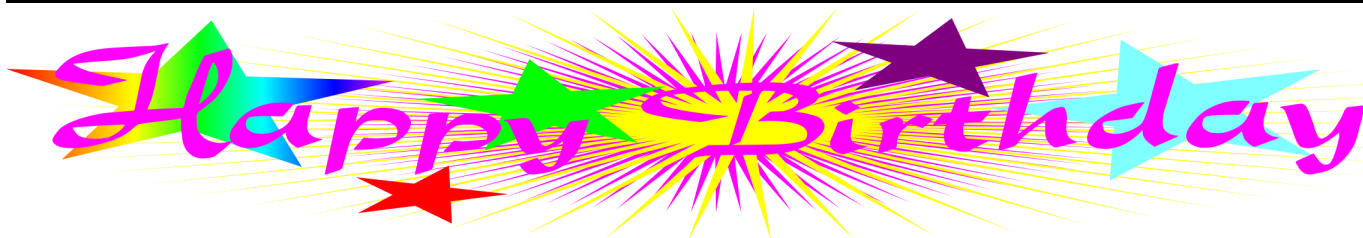
