At the December Stated Meeting, the members of Ben Hur Shrine will elect those individuals who will serve on the Divan and represent them at functions, meetings and ceremonies across Texas and at the Imperial Ceremonial. It is important that those who wish to ‘throw their fez in the ring’ and run for office know the rules established by Shriners International. The extract below is taken from Shriners International Bylaws for 2025 and explains what and what is not acceptable for a candidate while on the campaign trail.



Of primary interest is the position of Oriental Guide. This is the individual who will grow into a leader of the Temple and ensure the Nobility remember their obligation while having fun and supporting our hospitals. Choose this person wisely and your Shrine will grow.

§ 325.11 Election Regulations.

(a) **Electioneering.** A candidate for an elected office in a Shrine temple may print, publish and circulate during the year he is seeking the elected office, a résumé consisting of his educational background, his vocational history, and his Masonic and Shrine record. Except as provided in the prior sentence, the printing, publication, circulating or distribution of resolutions, letters, telegrams, tickets, email or other devices, by a unit, club, Noble, or group of Nobles, suggesting, recommending, opposing, or containing the names of proposed candidates for office in the temple is prohibited.

(b) **Expenditures Prohibited.** The expenditure of money for gifts, favors, or entertainment on behalf of a candidate for elected office is prohibited.

(c) **Violation.** For any violation of (a) or (b), the Imperial Potentate may suspend any offending Noble, and he may declare the election of the officers void and order a new election.

(d) **Notice.** At least one week prior to the annual meeting or any election, the temple Recorder shall mail to each member a notice thereof containing this section.

HISTORY

Forty-Five Novices Walk the Hot Sands in Kenedy, Texas

March 5, 1914, there was excitement in the air, as a train, horseback riders and a vehicle caravan arrived in, newly incorporated, Kenedy, Texas. The Shriners of Ben Hur Temple in Austin arrived on the train at the Kenedy Depot greeted by Mayor Thames and a group of dignitaries. Mayor Thames presented Potentate Soule with the keys to the city. Kenedy, with a population of 1147 was formerly known as “Six Shooter Junction”, because of it’s rough and tumble reputation. The early trains coming into “Six Shooter Junction” were usually welcomed into town amidst volleys of pistol fire.

On March 5 forty-five novices were guided across the hot sands of the desert and made full fledged Shriners at the ceremonial session. The novices were attired in white robes since they were “Sons of the Desert”. The Ben Hur Band was decked out in white knickers, stockings and white jackets topped with white fezes. The candidates were “coerced” into carrying large signs that read “Lost”, “Stolen” and “Strayed”, which was a popular section of the personal column of rural newspapers.

Kenedy was also home to a Masonic Lodge and an Eastern Star Chapter with both organizations playing host to the Shriner event. A luncheon was held at the Episcopal Church which was followed by the Shriners Parade. The Kenedy newspaper reported that the grand parade was equal to or better than other parades witnessed in large cities like San Antonio. The Shriner Parade Costumes were reported to be extravagant to say the least and the Patrol Units on Horseback. The vehicles in the parade were a sight to behold. Once the parade was over, the novices were given a “crash” course in being a Shriner beginning at 6:00pm until about 11:00pm. The ceremonial was followed by a grand banquet served by the ladies of the Eastern Star Chapter in the J.L. Bain building while the Ben Hur Band provided musical entertainment. A host of speakers during the banquet praised the city of Kenedy for hosting the ceremonial event hoping that it might be repeated soon.

Editorial Note: The preceding account of events in 1914 in Kenedy when a news crew visited City Hall in Kenedy and saw picture on the wall of the Shrine Event in 1914. A former resident of Kenedy brought a news crew to City Hall and explained that the men in the funny hats were members of Klu Klux Klan. The former resident was quickly made aware of who the men in the picture were. The original account was published in the Kenedy Advance Newspaper. This event took place at a time when the jurisdiction of Ben Hur extended all the way to the coast.
