A couple of events coming up:

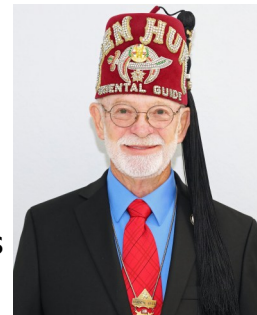
Thanks to the coordination of Ill. Sir Chuck Jones, we are once again sponsoring

HISTORY

A STAR IS BORN

August 1891, the Austin Statesman reports that Ben Hur Potentate and Judge D. W. Doom are currently in Chicago and have carte blanche from Ben Hur Temple to secure all the latest and most entertaining attractions for the use of the Shrine in the fall and winter of 1891. Judging from their well-known taste and experience in such matters those who contemplate joining as well as those who are now members can be assured of a season of unusual pleasure and useful and entertaining experiences. All of this is in preparation for the ceremonial and institution of Ben Hur Shrine Temple by Illustrious Noble George Green of Hella Shrine Temple of Dallas, Texas. Noble Green has declared that jurisdictional bounds have been suspended and any masons wishing to join the Mystic Shrine at the ceremonial and institution of Ben Hur Temple are welcome to do so. So far ninety-three candidates from all over central Texas have expressed their desire to join. Notable Shriners representing Kansas, Iowa, New York and Ohio have already arrived to participate in the festivities along with Texas Grand Lodge officials.

October 15, 1891, on this day Ben Hur Shrine Temple will be instituted at the Masonic Temple with the grandest and most imposing masonic ceremonial ever witnessed in the South. For weeks goods and paraphernalia have been arriving by freight and express for this event. Shriners and those waiting to participate in the ceremonies are made happy.

By proclamation of the Imperial Grand Council directed to the Commander of this jurisdiction, Illustrious Potentate of Hella Shrine, George H. Green commanding him with his followers to enter upon and make a pilgrimage across the hot sands of the desert to the oasis of Austin for the purpose of instituting the new Temple of Ben Hur and confer the Orders upon such that may desire the true light and assume the Arab's Vow. May the camels snort with glee and the dervishes laugh as scores of novices attempt the Arab's path.

The rules of the order decreed that all street parades must have camels with enough to furnish one each for the three "most holy sheiks" which must in parades be led by attendants in Arab garb. Nobles Morse and Doom have contracted with Barnum and Baily Circus for six camels to be delivered to Monroe Millers Livery Stable.

There will be a practice meeting in the morning with a business meeting to follow where necessary business will be conducted. First section of the ceremonial will follow with the second section where the novices will experience the hot sands of the desert. A grand banquet with tables set for three hundred nobles will be on the roof top of the Austin Hotel. The ladies dinner will be at the relatively new Driskill Hotel with an evening of theatre performances.

It was also reported that ninety-nine masonic applicants were initiated at the Scottish Rite Temple.

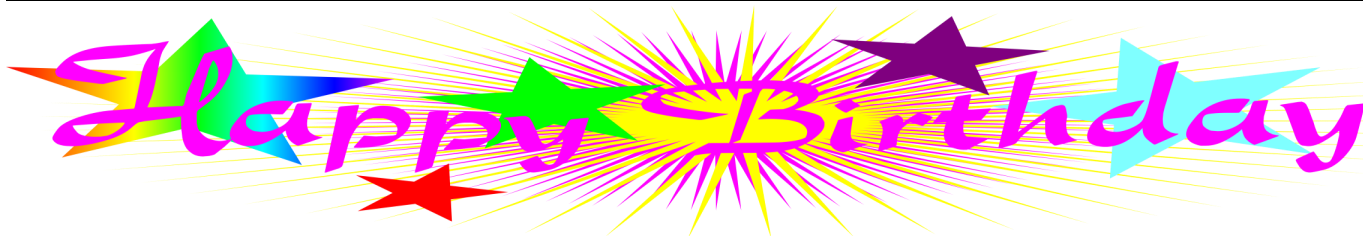
