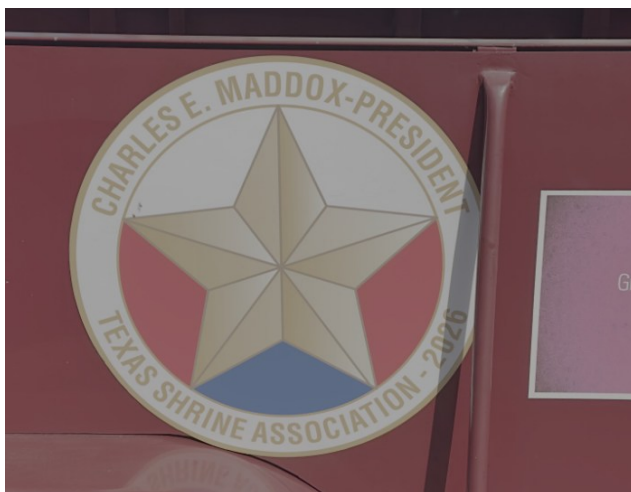
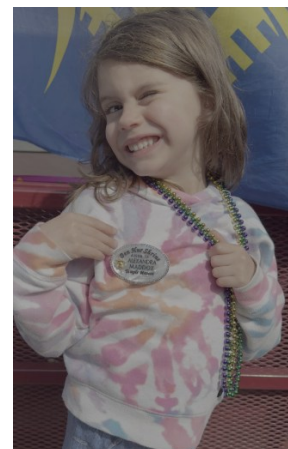

HISTORY

ONE HUNDRED AND SIXTY-EIGHT YEARS OF SERVICE

In about 1850 settlers moved into the area on Cibolo Creek west of San Antonio and started a community they called Live Oak Grove. It was later changed to La Vernia. As the settlement grew the masons in the area had to travel about twenty miles to the nearest lodge. In 1858 one of the prominent farmers in the area named Robert W. Brahan proposed that the masons in Lavernia seek their own masonic lodge. The original members of the lodge were from Tennessee, Alabama and Georgia having served in every American war. The lodge set to work on June 28, 1858, and was chartered on June 16, 1859, probably conducting their meetings in a cabin in the area.

In the 1860's the members made plans for a permanent meeting hall, selecting a site on the brow of a hill just west of La Vernia. Haywood Brahan and James Newton arranged the purchase of two acres of land from Ms. Georgia Morgan for the princely sum \$25.00. Funds were scarce for the building of a hall so the members, true to their heritage, commenced the building of the lodge hall. It is said that this is probably the only Masonic Lodge Hall built for the express purpose of serving as a church, school and lodge hall. Stone was quarried in the area and hauled by ox cart to the building site where the members constructed the two-story structure completing it, ready for use in 1871. It has been in continuous use since its completion. In 1880 the charter was given up due to friction resulting from various disciplinary actions. The charter was restored in 1884 and the lodge has labored harmoniously since then to advance the cause of Masonry.

In 1958-58 the building was renovated. Walls were straightened, replastered and reinforced. Brother Robert Brown, then seventy-five years old, painted the interior with Masonic murals taken from the monitor. Furniture made from native cedar was donated to the lodge and upholstered chairs were purchased by the lodge.

Probably the most momentous event to take place in the long history of the lodge was the centennial observance on June 6, 1959. After long planning the event was attended by more than 1250 people. The ceremony was opened at 8:30 in the morning by reading a proclamation by Governor Price Daniel declaring June 6, 1959, as Brahan Lodge Centennial Day in Texas. Arriving guests were treated to a tour of the building during which most expressed amazement at the beauty of the murals gracing the walls. A book of the lodge history, *A Century of Light*, sold nearly 800 copies. A copy of *A Century of Light* written by D. L. West was presented to the Grand Master of Masons in Texas by the Junior Warden Bethel Harlow.

Following the official reception of Grand Master Randall Briscoe, a barbecue chicken dinner was served to guests at the La Vernia Chamber of Commerce Grounds, after which an evening program was held. Past Masters, life members, officers, wives, members of the La Vernia Chapter of the Order of Eastern Star and dignitaries were introduced. The Alzafar Shrine Chanters were present and entertained the gathering with several songs.

In attendance at the centennial were Masons from every Masonic District in Texas, with nine Deputy Grand Masters present. Nineteen state lodges and two foreign countries were represented.

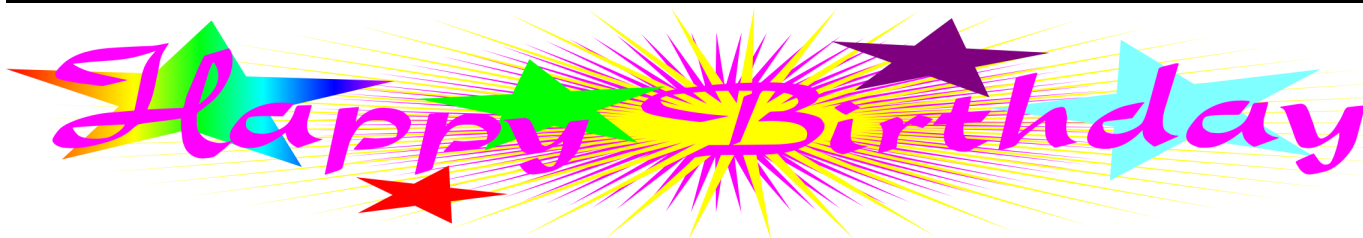
